

# Geology Digimap Educational User Licence

The Digimap Service contains data owned by or licensed to the United Kingdom Research and Innovation (represented by the British Geological Survey (BGS)), such data being “the BGS Data”.

This Licence sets out the terms for your use of the BGS Data.
