



### Your tasks:

- Import a file to add symbols to your map:
  - Select Drawing Tools > Import > select the file [antonine wall forts.csv](#)
  - When prompted, select X field = Eastings, Y field = Northings, Projection = British National Grid.
- **Add a text label**, 'Antonine Wall Forts'- go to Drawing Tools > Create.
- **Basemap** – try out different basemaps. We used Background, to make the symbols more visible.
- **Save your map** – go to MyMaps > Save.
- **Print** – create an **A4 portrait PDF print file**. Set the scale at 1:500000.

### Tips:

- Check out the Drawing Tools > Create area, to see what other symbols and shapes you can add to maps.
- It's a good idea to set text size, shape and line colour BEFORE you start drawing.

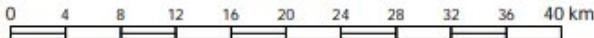
