

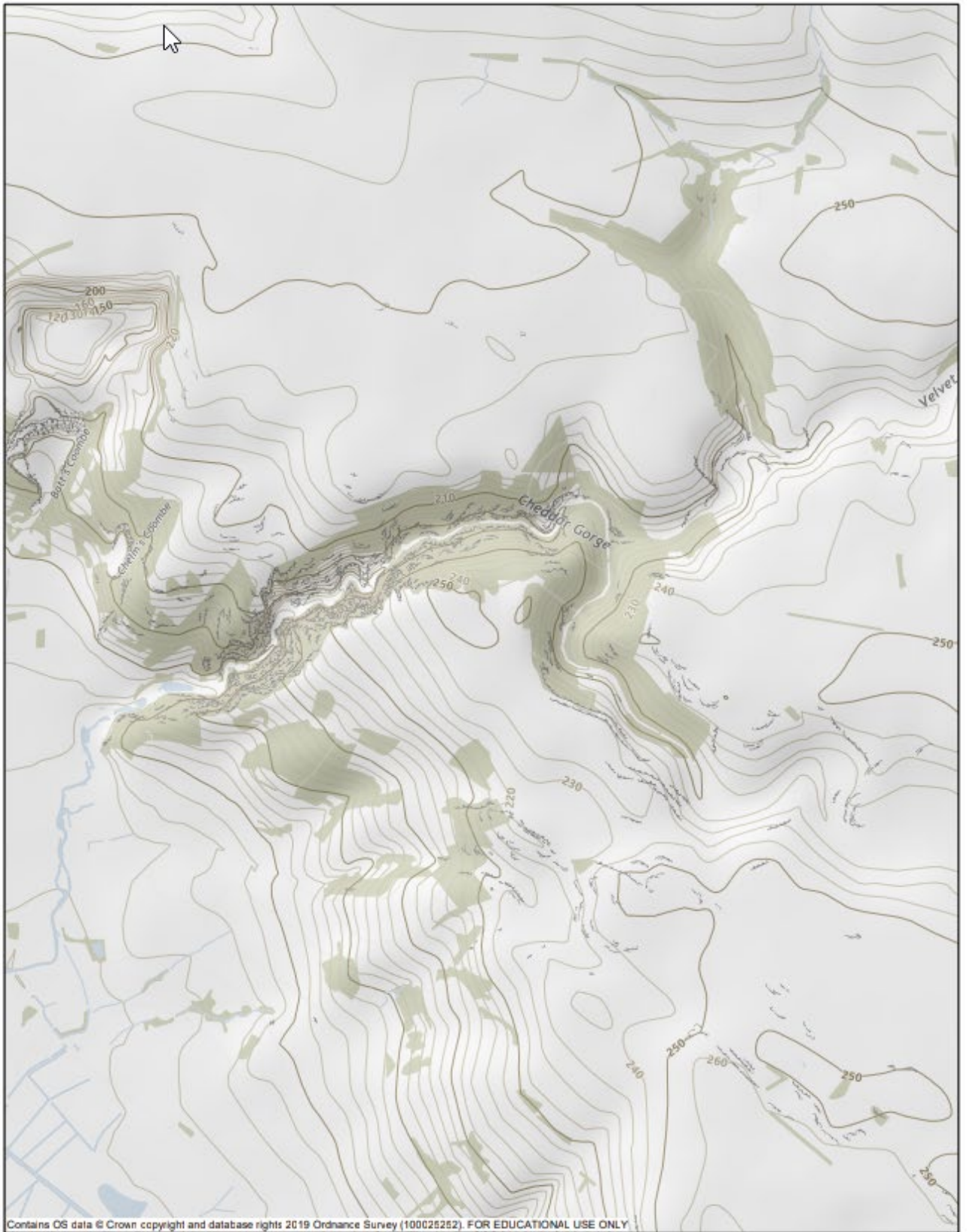
Your tasks:

1. Try and view a map on screen that resembles the map in the above image.
2. Find out which Ordnance Survey maps you are viewing and the date of publication.

Tips:

- **Location** – the map image is of Cheddar Gorge, in Somerset.
- **Scale** – zoom to a Local view map. Find the view name at the bottom right of the map window.
- **Basemap** – try selecting the **Vector Map District** (button on the map window).
- **Map Content** - find **Map Content** in the sidebar and turn off all layers except Natural Features and Height information.
- **Overlays** – we have switched on the Hill Shading overlay. Find the Overlays menu and try it out.
- **Map Information** – check this area in the sidebar to find details of your OS map.
