The 1:50 000 Scale Gazetteer consists of some 250 000 names taken from the OS Landranger Map series. The quality of the 1:50 000 Scale Gazetteer is constantly monitored to ensure the accuracy of records held.

Availability

The gazetteer provides coverage of Great Britain as one seamless file and is updated annually.

1:50 000 Scale Gazetteer has national coverage of Great Britain and is not available to purchase as separate countries or by individual tile.

Quality

Ordnance Survey quality assurance and quality control procedures are applied. Please note that the easting and northing coordinate given for each gazetteer entry is accurate only to the centre of the km square in which that name falls.

Supply format

The 1:50 000 Scale Gazetteer is provided as a text file, with records separated by colons.

Media

The 1:50 000 Scale Gazetteer is available on CD-ROM ISO 966 high Sierra only.

File sizes

The volume of data is approximately 24 Mb.

Updates

Every time a change is made to a name on the Landranger production database, the equivalent name is amended on the gazetteer. This change could include a positional move to a name, to improve its cartographic representation, or the addition of a new name.

An updated 1:50 000 Scale Gazetteer is made available in June of each year and is supplied automatically under the terms of your business geographics agreement with Ordnance Survey. This date coincides with the updates of 1:50 000 Scale Colour Raster data becoming available.

What is needed to use the product?

Ideally the 1:50 000 Scale Gazetteer should be used within a geographical information system (GIS) (not provided by Ordnance Survey) as a location and/or search tool for reference with 1:50 000 scale mapping.

Full county	As above for county, but UA and/or county name appears in full.		
NG reference	The National Grid reference comprising two letters and four figures, identifying the km square in which the name falls.		
Lat and/or long	The latitude and longitude to 0.1 of a minute of the centre point of the National Grid square (1 km by 1 km) in which the name falls.
